It is just over half a century since Turkey landed in Cyprus, causing thousands to flee their homes north and south. Repeated talks have been held to bring long-term peace to the island, but to little effect.

Now more than ever, the island's future has become part of a much wider dynamic. The discovery of oil and gas in the Eastern Mediterranean has entrenched divisions. Turkey is demanding recognition of Northern Cyprus before anything else.

This seven-day tour introduces us to leaders and communities on both sides, visits the UN's controlled buffer zone or green line, and gets the latest expertise on one of the most entrenched disputes of our time.
